## Collective Labour Agreement of 27 June 2013 establishing the wage conditions in the culture dissemination sector

**Article 1.** This collective labour agreement applies to the employers and employees of the culture dissemination organisations of the sector that fall under the Joint Committee for the socio-cultural sector of the Flemish Community and are structurally subsidised (multi-year, not temporary or related to an experiment or project) on basis of:

- the decree of 2 April 2004 on subsidising "arts organisations, artists, arts education organisations and socio-artistic activities, international initiatives, publications and support centres (as amended)
- the decree of 23 May 2008 on the development, organisation and subsidisation of Flemish cultural heritage policy (as amended)
- the decree of 13 July 2001 on the promotion of a quality, integrated local cultural policy, as a provision for special target groups for public library work (Title III, Chapter III, Section VI
- the decree of 3 March 1976 for the protection of monuments, and town and village views (as amended), as monument watch or as monument watch umbrella organisation.
- a nominative subsidy in the culture or real estate heritage budget.

Employees are understood to mean male and female blue and white-collar personnel.

**Article 2.** This collective labour agreement, in the wage scale structure below, establishes the general rules regarding wage scales. Existing more favourable conditions are retained.

**Article 3.** This collective labour agreement is being concluded for an indefinite period. It comes into force on 1 January 2013.

It may be terminated at the request of a signatory, giving three months' notice by registered letter addressed to the chair of the joint subcommittee.
